## A Need To Be Concerned?

"We – with God's help – call on every Muslim who believes in God and wishes to be rewarded, to comply with God's order to kill the Americans and plunder their money wherever and whenever they find it. We also call on the Muslim community, leaders, and soldiers, to launch the raid on Satan's U.S. Troops and the devil's supporters allying with them, and to displace those who are behind them so that they may learn a lesson" (Declaration of War issued by Osama bin Laden, in Afghanistan, February 23, 1998).

Do some grow faint from the thought of humans stalking other humans and then, like depraved animals, detonate a dirty bomb in the midst of a well-traveled airport, killing and maiming thousands – all in the name of religion? Does it make them shudder to think that their children, attending a matinee show on a Saturday afternoon, could become victims to an exploding backpack left under a seat by an angry soul who disagrees with the American way of life?
